- Confers with the Head of Clinical on referral, screening, evaluations and any unusual circumstances arising from referrals or active student cases.
- Confers with other schools, providing information on the service of the TLC programs.
- Actively contributes to the development of programs for children with special needs in Qatar(i.e. consultation, presentations)
- Assists in End of Year data collection regarding annual school-wide assessments
- Assists with developing and/or implementing behavior intervention programs
- Has an experience in response to intervention model.
- Assists in the implementation of school-wide behaviour programs
